Without Planning Permission the placing on the land of a caravan approximately in the position marked with an X on the plan.

4 REASONS FOR ISSUING THIS NOTICE

It appears to the Authority that the above breach of planning control has occurred within the last ten years. There are no special circumstances justifying the siting of a residential caravan on the land and the development is contrary to 2.3.22 of the Dartmoor National Park Local Plan (First Review 1995-2011) and to policy C3 of the Devon Structure Plan (First Review 1995-2011).

5 WHAT YOU ARE REQUIRED TO DO

Remove the caravan from the land permanently.

6 TIME FOR COMPLIANCE

Within one month after this Notice takes effect.

7 WHEN THIS NOTICE TAKES EFFECT

This Notice takes effect on 25 October 2002, unless an appeal is made against it beforehand.
