DARTMOOR NATIONAL PARK LOCAL PLAN 2018-2036 ADOPTION STATEMENT

Dartmoor National Park Authority adopted the Dartmoor Local Plan 2018-2036 on 3 December 2021. This development plan document sets out strategic policies, development management policies, minerals and waste development policies and site allocations to guide spatial development within Dartmoor National Park in the period up to 2036.

The Local Plan was the subject of an independent examination conducted by Ms R Barrett BSc MSc Dup Hist Cons MRTPI IHBC, the Inspector appointed by the Secretary of State. The examination included public hearings between 2 and 12 March 2021. The Inspector's Report was issued on 1 November 2021 and concluded that the Local Plan is sound and legally compliant, subject to the Inspector's main modifications pursuant to Section 20 of the Planning and Compulsory Purchase Act 2004. Any person aggrieved by the adoption of the Local Plan may make an application to the High Court under section 113 of the Planning and Compulsory Purchase Act 2004 no later than six weeks after it is adopted.

The Inspector's Report, the Local Plan, Sustainability Appraisal report and Adoption Statement are available on the Authority's web site www.dartmoor.gov.uk/planning. They are also available for public inspection at the authority's offices (below) (during normal office hours - currently by appointment only due to Covid access restrictions). Hard copies will be made available as soon as reasonably possible in local libraries and a copy held by each Parish/Town Council wholly or partly within Dartmoor National Park.
