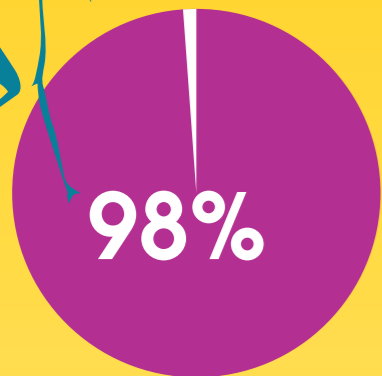


Dartmoor National Park

The Blue Ground Beetle - the **largest** and one of the **rarest** beetles in the UK is mainly found on Dartmoor



98% residents are satisfied with living on Dartmoor



45% of South West Waters' daily supply of **429 million litres**, sources on Dartmoor



10 megatonnes of carbon could be stored in the soils of Dartmoor, equivalent to an entire year of **carbon dioxide (CO₂)** output from UK industry!

429 million litres



For every **£1** spent by Dartmoor National Park Authority **£4** is generated for the local economy

The Cuckoos that summer on Dartmoor, over-winter in Congolese tropical rainforests - a round trip of **10,000 miles!**

Dartmoor has the **southernmost** blanket bogs in Europe

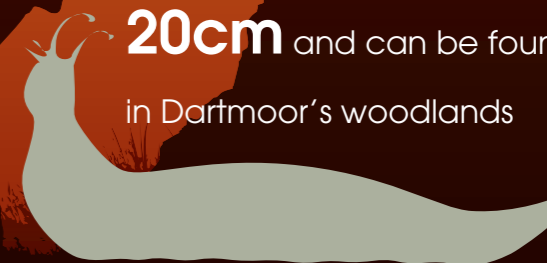


Dartmoor has the UK's **largest** colony of Deptford Pink

93% of people are satisfied with Dartmoor National Park services



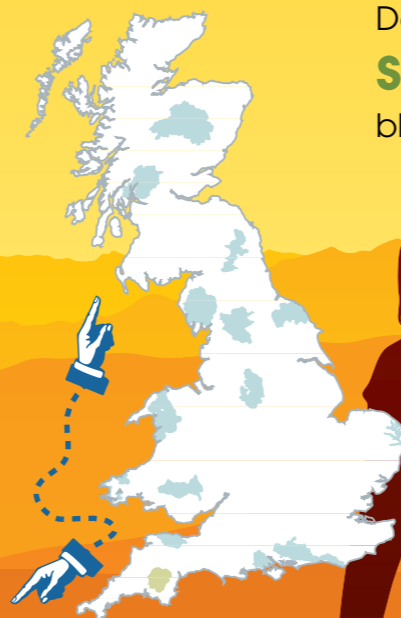
The world's **largest land slug**, the Ash Black Slug, can exceed **20cm** and can be found in Dartmoor's woodlands



2,800 listed buildings

1,078 scheduled monuments

Dartmoor has **450 miles** of public rights of way - the equivalent of walking from Land's End to Penrith in Cumbria



90% of Dartmoor is used for farming, with **37%** being on common land

Most important area for Bronze Age archaeology in Western Europe!

The **only place** the Bog Hover Fly exists in Britain!

Stallmoor stone row is the **longest in the world - 3.4km** (60% of all stone rows in England are on Dartmoor)
