




Burrator Arboretum

A self-guided walk exploring the woodlands around Burrator. The suggested walking route will help you experience some of Dartmoor's wonderful wildlife while taking in the sounds of nearby running water.

Please be aware of your own limitations and navigational abilities before embarking on any of our Miles Without Stiles routes.

ROUTE INFORMATION

Parking - The Arboretum has its own car park

Facilities - Public toilets just south of the dam are open seven days a week. Distance -Total distance of 800m - 1 km (circular route).

Time - 30 minutes to one hour Character - sheltered, wet broadleaved woodland, some conifer forest, stream

This sheltered and level route follows a wide and winding surfaced path through wet broadleaved woodland, some conifer forest and alongside a stream and ponds.

There is a boardwalk section along the stream and a range of wonderful trees to see along the way.

If you enjoy wandering in woodland, spotting dragonflies, counting the different birds you can hear and listening to running water, then this is the place for you.

This wonderful walk offers an easy access route for visitors of all levels looking to enjoy a gentle wonder around a network of ponds, taking in a variety of habitats and of course Burrator Reservoir.
