Designation of Ashburton Neighbourhood Plan Area

I am pleased to advise that the Dartmoor National Park Authority has approved Ashburton Town Council's proposal to designate a Neighbourhood Area, for the purposes of preparing a Neighbourhood Development Plan. As the proposal covers two local planning authority areas, Teignbridge District Council will also write to confirm its approval of the designation of the part of the Ashburton's Neighbourhood Area that falls outside the boundary of the National Park.

Both authorities will work jointly to support the Town Council's preparation of the Neighbourhood Plan and officers will be happy to meet with you to discuss how the Town Council would like to take the proposal forward. Officers will be able to offer advice on the legal requirements the plan must adhere to, consultation and engagement processes and on the national and local planning and other policies and regulations that your Neighbourhood Development Plan must conform with.
