The Dartmoor National Park Authority Bridleway 10, Footpath 11 & Footpath 35 (Lustleigh) (Temporary Prohibition of Through Traffic) Order 2025

1. Dartmoor National Park Authority makes this Order in exercise of its powers under section 22BB (2) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 as applied by the National Park Authorities' Traffic Orders (Procedure)(England) Regulations 2007.
2. The Order shall come into operation at 0800hrs on Monday 13 October 2025 until 1300 hrs on Thursday 16 October 2025.
3. The restriction specified will only have effect at such times and to such extent as indicated by the display of notices.
4. The duration of the Order can be extended with the approval of the Secretary of State for Transport.
5. While the Order is in operation no person shall proceed along:

During such times as the appropriate traffic signs are displayed

6. In this order 'traffic sign' means any sign or notice erected on the public rights of way contained within section 5 of the Order by the Authority pursuant to section 64 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984.
