<u>Mature Trees - Individual</u>		
M1 - Lime	Mature specimen tree / High amenity value / offsite (but influences design)	BS Cat = A1
M2 - Beech	Mature specimen tree / High amenity value / part of linear group LSP1	BS Cat = A2
<u>Landscape Feature (tree group)</u>		
LSP1 -	Mixed species linear tree group, predominantly: Sycamore (75%), Beech, Willow, Ash, Oak Semi-mature - Middle-aged / High visual impact / High amenity value Lack of previous management	BS Cat = B2
LSP2 -	Mixed species area of self sown scrub / High habitat & wildlife potential Stream side vegetation / Young - Middle-aged vegetation	BS Cat = B2
LSP3/4 -	Mixed species linear feature adjacent to and screening A38 High landscape value	BS Cat = B2
<u>Mature Tree Group</u>		
MTG1 -	Group of mature trees, Macrocarpa (80%), 2xSycamore, 1xAsh Suitable screening for current site (light industrial/commercial) NOT viable for long term retention - depending on site use. Short safe useful life expectancy	BS Cat = C2
MTG2 -	3x Lombardy Poplar - Mature Suitable screening for current site (light industrial/commercial) NOT viable for long term retention - depending on site use. Short safe useful life expectancy	BS Cat = C2
